COOKIE POLICY

Person responsible for the treatment

Scope

In order to help you navigate Integer's website and provide a better service to the user, we use cookies to improve performance and your user experience, as well as the quality of information you access and your user experience.

What type of cookies do we use?

Our website uses the following types of cookies:

- Technical cookies: they allow the user to navigate on the webpage and the use of different options or services therein, for example, control traffic and data communication, identify the session, access to the restricted parts, etc.
- Preference/personalisation cookies: they allow the user to access the service with some predefined general characteristics such as, for example, the language, the type of browser through which the user accesses the service, the regional configuration from where they access the service, etc.
- Analysis cookies (statistical and marketing): they are used to monitor and analyse user behaviour. They are used in measuring web activity, drawing up browsing profiles, etc.

What type of cookies do we use on our website?

You can configure cookies in the "options" or "preferences" menu of the browser.



The "STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES (4)" option cannot be changed.




